THE EXHIBITOR'S AFFIDAVIT OR THE PHOTOCOPY OF THE TRADER'S LICENSE SHALL BE DISPLAYED CONSPICUOUSLY DURING THE SHOW.

(C) SUBMITTING AFFIDAVITS TO COMPTROLLER.

WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER A SHOW ENDS, THE PROMOTER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COMPTROLLER THE EXHIBITORS' AFFIDAVITS.

17–1815. VIOLATING PROVISIONS ON LICENSES FOR VISUALLY HANDICAPPED INDIVIDUALS OR BLIND INDUSTRIES; PENALTY.

A PERSON, INCLUDING A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, WHO VIOLATES OR CONSPIRES TO VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT RELATES TO TRADER'S LICENSES FOR VISUALLY HANDICAPPED INDIVIDUALS OR BLIND INDUSTRIES IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH.
