

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE TO SUBTITLE:

Former Art. 56, § 95, which provided a procedure for the County Commissioners of Allegany and Washington counties to revoke a trader's license for the sale of gasoline, is deleted as obsolete and as covered by Title 10 of this article ("Motor Fuel and Lubricants").

SUBTITLE 19. VENDING MACHINES.

17-1901. "VENDING MACHINE LICENSE" DEFINED.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "VENDING MACHINE LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE CLERK TO SELL GOODS OR OFFER GOODS FOR SALE THROUGH A VENDING MACHINE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language added to avoid repetition of the phrase "license to sell goods or offer for sale goods through a vending machine".

17-1902. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SALE OR OFFERING FOR SALE OF CIGARETTES, NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, PAPER CUPS, PAPER OR CLOTH TOWELS, SOAP, TOILET SEAT COVERS, POSTAGE STAMPS, OR SANITARY NAPKINS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the sixth sentence of former Art. 56, § 74(b) and the exception for cigarettes in (a).

As to the sale of cigarettes through a vending machine, see Title 16 of this article.

17-1903. LICENSE REQUIRED.

WHENEVER A PERSON SELLS GOODS OR OFFERS GOODS FOR SALE THROUGH A VENDING MACHINE IN THE STATE, THE PERSON MUST HAVE A VENDING MACHINE LICENSE THAT COVERS THAT MACHINE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 74(a), as it related to the requirement to get a license.

It is rephrased in standard language to state affirmatively that a person must be licensed to sell goods or offer goods for sale through a vending machine.
