

3-307. CONSULTATION ON REGULATIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL ADVISE AND CONSULT WITH THE COMMISSIONER ON REASONABLE REGULATIONS TO PREVENT CONDITIONS THAT ARE DETRIMENTAL TO THE PUBLIC IN THEIR USE OF AMUSEMENT ATTRACTIONS.

3-308. RECOMMENDATIONS ON REGULATIONS.

(A) BY BOARD.

THE BOARD SHALL RECOMMEND TO THE COMMISSIONER ANY REGULATION THAT IT FINDS NECESSARY FOR THE PROTECTION AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC.

(B) BY COMMISSIONER.

THE COMMISSIONER MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD ON REGULATIONS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the second sentence of former Art. 89, § 70(a) and, as it related to recommendations and proposals, the first sentence.

In subsection (b) of this section, the former phrase "as he deems necessary to carry out the intent of this subtitle" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the word "may" and the duty, under § 3-201 of this title, to administer this title.
