

in the Board by the provisions of this subtitle, shall be subject to the power and authority of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation as set forth in [Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland,] THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE or elsewhere in the laws of this State.

(b) The Board may adopt and enforce rules and regulations necessary for the administration of examinations and disciplinary actions and the holding of hearings before it. The Board shall formulate and adopt a code of ethics which shall be regarded as the standard of conduct required by the Board for all persons licensed under the provisions of this subtitle.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 2A-1; 20A and 20C; and the subtitle "Amusement Devices"; 31A and 31B; 134A through 134C and the subtitle "Gypsies, Fortune-Tellers, etc."; 191 through 200A and the subtitle "Regulation of Animals", respectively, of Article 56 - Licenses of the Annotated Code of Maryland be transferred to be Section(s) 11-101 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 1. General Provisions"; 11-201 and 11-202 to be under the amended subtitle "Subtitle 2. Amusement Devices"; 11-301 and 11-302 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 3. Transient or Temporary Vendors"; 11-401 through 11-403 to be under the amended subtitle "Subtitle 4. Fortune-Tellers"; and 11-501 through 11-511 to be under the amended subtitle "Subtitle 5. Regulation of Animals", respectively, all to be under the new title "Title 11. Licenses" of Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 200B and the subtitle "Police Dogs - Licensing of" of Article 56 - Licenses of the Annotated Code of Maryland be transferred to be Section(s) 70 to be under the amended subtitle "Licensing of Police Dogs" of Article 88B - State Police of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 366 and the subtitle "Surveillance" of Article 56 - Licenses of the Annotated Code of Maryland be transferred to be Section(s) 555 to be under the new subheading "Surveillance" of Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to affect any valid seal that a licensee or permit holder holds before October 1, 1992.

SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the revisor's notes and catchlines contained in this Act are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this Act.
