3-311. ACTION BY COMMISSIONER.

IF, AFTER RECEIVING A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE BOARD FOR A REGULATION, THE COMMISSIONER DECIDES TO ADOPT THE REGULATION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ADOPTION IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 89, § 70(d).

The former reference to a "public hearing" to give "interested persons" an opportunity "to submit data or views in writing or orally" is deleted as unnecessary in light of SG § 10-112(a)(3)(ii), which provides an opportunity for persons to comment before adoption of a proposed regulation.

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3-312. DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE COMMISSIONER MAY DELAY THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF A REGULATION FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION OF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION, IF THE COMMISSIONER FINDS THAT THE DELAY IS NEEDED TO ENSURE THAT EACH MANUFACTURER, OPERATOR, OR AMUSEMENT OWNER OF AN AMUSEMENT ATTRACTION AFFECTED BY THE REGULATION KNOWS ABOUT AND HAS AN OPPORTUNITY TO FAMILIARIZE EMPLOYEES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE REGULATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the second sentence of former Art. 89, § 70(f).

The phrase "after publication of the notice of adoption" is added to clarify the date on which the 90-day period would begin. This addition is based on SG § 10-117(a)(1)(i), which generally precludes a regulation becoming effective until the 10th day after publication of the notice.
