

[(ii)](2) The child fails to comply with an alcohol education or rehabilitation program referral [under paragraph (2)(i) of this subsection]; or

[(iii)](3) The child fails to comply with a supervised work program assignment [under paragraph (2)(ii) of this subsection].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
