

Article 83C - Juvenile Services

2-117.

(a) (1) The Department may establish and operate the facilities that are necessary to diagnose, care for, train, educate, and rehabilitate properly children who need these services.

(2) These facilities include:

(i) The J. Deweese Carter Center;

(ii) The Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School;

(iii) The Alfred D. Noyes Children's Center;

(iv) [The Boys' Village of Maryland] CHELTENHAM YOUTH FACILITY;

(v) The Thomas J. S. Waxter Children's Center; and

(vi) The youth centers.

(b) Before the Department asks the General Assembly for a bond issue to build or renovate a facility, the Department shall consult on the proposed construction or renovation plans with the governing body of the county where the facility is to be built or renovated and with the governing body of each county to be served.

Article - Education

6-303.

(a) An individual employed as a teacher, librarian, principal, director of education, or supervisor of vocational education on the staffs of the following institutions or in the following programs shall be paid an annual salary of not less than the salary received by a public school teacher or public school librarian of similar training and experience in the county where the institution is located:

(1) [Boys' Village of Maryland] CHELTENHAM YOUTH FACILITY;

(2) [Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School;

(3) Victor Cullen School;

(4) Any [other] institution that is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Human Resources or the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and

[(5)](3) Any vocational rehabilitation programs of the State Department of Education, the Division of Correction of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, or the Patuxent Institution.
