

Article 64A – Merit System

3.

The following positions shall not be included in the classified service:

(15) All teachers, principals, directors of education and supervisors of vocational education on the staffs of [Boys' Village of Maryland, Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School, Montrose School] CHELTENHAM YOUTH FACILITY, and any and all other institutions which are under the supervision, direction, control and general management of the Department of Juvenile Services;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the approval of the Director of the Department of Legislative Reference, the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall change any and all references to the "Boys' Village of Maryland" in the Annotated Code of Maryland that are rendered incorrect by Section 1 of this Act.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 9

(Senate Bill 109)

AN ACT concerning

Disabled Persons – Guardian of the Estate

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a local area agency on aging from serving as guardian of the estate of disabled persons.

Section 13-207(e)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Estates and Trusts

13-207.

(e) The court may not name an official or employee of a local department of social services, the State Department of Human Resources, A LOCAL AREA AGENCY ON AGING AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 70B, § 1(B) OF THE CODE, or the Office on Aging as guardian of the estate.
