

(4) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection, for fiscal year [1993] 1994 and each fiscal year thereafter, the total user fees assessed by the Commission shall be equal to 4 times the net State contribution.

(5) The Commission shall pay all funds collected from user fees and application fees into the General Fund of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 16

(Senate Bill 151)

AN ACT concerning

Standards for Counseling Individuals by Pharmacists

FOR the purpose of requiring pharmacists to provide certain information to Medical Assistance recipients; specifying the manner in which an offer to discuss may be made; providing an exception; requiring pharmacists to obtain, record, and maintain certain information from Medical Assistance recipients; authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to take certain disciplinary action for a violation of this Act; providing for the application of this Act; requiring that certain regulations be adopted in a certain manner; making provisions of this Act severable; and generally relating to the Medical Assistance Program.
