**CHAPTER 22**

**(Senate Bill 266)**

**A BILL ENTITLED**

AN ACT concerning

**Annual Corrective Bill**

FOR the purpose of correcting certain errors and omissions in certain articles of the Annotated Code and in certain uncodified laws and public local laws; clarifying language; providing that this Act is not intended to affect any law other than to correct technical errors; repealing certain obsolete provisions of law relating to the provision of certain law books to the Office of the Attorney General by the State Law Library; codifying certain uncodified provisions of law; requiring the publishers of the Annotated Code to make certain changes in the Code to effectuate certain termination provisions; renumbering certain sections of the Annotated Code; reorganizing certain sections of the Annotated Code; ratifying certain corrections made by the publishers of the Annotated Code; providing for the effect and construction of certain provisions of this Act and Chapter 8 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991; and making this Act an emergency measure.
