

(2) The hours for sale are as provided in § 106(c).

(3) In Worcester County light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.

[(m) In Calvert County the annual license fee shall be \$250.

(n) In Kent County any restaurant meeting the definition of restaurant in § 101 may apply for a special Class B beer and light wine license, subject to approval of the Board. The annual fee for this license is \$1,000.

(n-1) In Somerset County the annual fee for this license is \$200.

(o) In St. Mary's County the annual fee for this license is \$400.

(p) In Howard County any restaurant meeting the definition of restaurant under § 2(p) of this article may apply for a Class B beer and light wine license, subject to approval of the Board. The annual fee for this license is \$175.

(q) (1) In Dorchester County, a Class B (on and off-sale) beer and light wine license:

- (i) Shall only be issued to restaurants;
- (ii) Shall be issued without seating capacity restrictions; and
- (iii) The annual fee is \$200.

(2) A holder shall purchase all of the wine sold under this license from the Dorchester County Liquor Control Board dispensaries.

(r) This section shall not apply to Allegany, Charles, Garrett, and Talbot Counties, in all of which jurisdictions such licenses shall not be issued.]

(o) (4) Any licensee who holds a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license under Section 19(n)(1) or [(4)] (2) of this article or a Class B beer and wine license under Section 14[(g)](N), and who has been granted an option to the existing license that allows for off-sale liquor is subject to § 19(n)[(6)](3) of this article.
