- 4. That is not considered to be a fast-food style facility.
- [(4)](5) [A Class B beer, wine and liquor] THIS license authorizes the holder to sell beer, wine and liquor by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises only.
  - [(5)](6) This license does not have off-sale privileges.
- [(6)](7) The requirements for hours and days of sale are as provided under Section 91(a) and (b) of this article.
  - [(7)](8) The annual license fee is \$750.
- [(8)](9) This [Class B beer, wine and liquor] license is exempt from any license population quota limitation.
- [(9)](10) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, this license may not be transferred to a location other than the premises for which it was issued.
- (c) (1) [In Anne Arundel County, outside of the City of Annapolis, the annual license fee is \$900.] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLY ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY AND DO NOT APPLY TO THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS.
- (2) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A CLASS B LICENSE IS \$900.
- [(b) (1)] (3) (I) A Class H beer, wine and liquor license authorizes the holder to keep for sale and sell beer, wine and liquor at retail at any restaurant for consumption on the premises.
  - [(2) This subsection applies to Anne Arundel County.
  - (3)] (II) The annual fee for this license is \$800.
- [(c-1)](D) (1) (i) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, in Baltimore City the annual license fee is \$1,000.
- (II) IN THIS PARAGRAPH "47TH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT" APPLIES TO THE FOLLOWING AREAS OF BALTIMORE CITY:
  - 1. WARDS 23, 24, AND 25 IN THEIR ENTIRETY;
  - 2. WARD 19, PRECINCTS 3, 4, AND 5;
  - 3. WARD 20, PRECINCTS 19 AND 20;
  - 4. WARD 21, PRECINCTS 2 AND 3; AND
- 5. WARD 21, THAT PART OF PRECINCT 1 THAT LIES SOUTH AND WEST OF A LINE THAT RUNS ALONG THE CENTER OF HARBOR CITY BOULEVARD FROM EUTAW STREET TO PRATT STREET.
