

[(5)](V) The valuation of the building for assessment and taxation purposes as set out in paragraphs [(2)] (II) and [(3) shall] (III) DO not affect or prohibit in any manner the renewal or transfer of any Class B license issued in Carroll County prior to May 1, 1979.

(2) (I) THERE IS A CLASS BC LICENSE.

[(a)](II) [In Carroll County, the] THE Board of License Commissioners may issue a Class BC restaurant or hotel and caterer's (on- and limited off-sale) beer, wine and liquor license to an applicant:

[(1)]1. Who has a restaurant or hotel which meets the licensure requirements and conditions provided under [§ 19(h) of this article] THIS SECTION; or

[(2)]2. Who is a holder of a Class B hotel or restaurant (on- and off-sale) beer, wine and liquor license issued in Carroll County, if the holder surrenders the license to the Board of License Commissioners before being issued a new license under this [section] PARAGRAPH.

[(b)](III) The Class BC restaurant or hotel and caterer's license issued under this section authorizes the holder to sell:

[(1)]1. Beer, wine and liquor, 7 days a week, on the restaurant or hotel premises for on-premises consumption;

[(2)]2. Beer, 7 days a week, on the restaurant or hotel premises for off-premises consumption; and

[(3)]3. Beer, wine and liquor, 7 days a week, at catered events held in Carroll County off the restaurant or hotel premises for on-premises consumption.

[(c)](IV) The holder of a license issued under this [section] PARAGRAPH shall provide food as well as alcoholic beverages for consumption at the catered event.

[(d)](V) The annual fee for a license issued under this [section] PARAGRAPH is \$250 more than the annual fee for a Class B hotel or restaurant (on- and off-sale) beer, wine and liquor license issued in Carroll County.

[(e)](VI) The holder of a license issued under this section may exercise the license privileges only during the hours and days that are permitted under this article for a Class B hotel or restaurant (on- and off-sale) beer, wine and liquor license issued in Carroll County.

(i) (1) In Cecil County the annual fee for this license is \$750.

(2) (i) Notwithstanding the license quota provisions of § 32 of this article, the Cecil County Board of License Commissioners may issue special Class B licenses known as Class BLX beer, wine and liquor on-sale restaurant licenses.
