

(ii) The holder of this license in Wicomico County may prohibit a person under the legal drinking age in the State from entering the lounge area on the licensed premises after 9:00 p.m., unless this person is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian who is of the legal drinking age in the State.

(iii) The holder of this license may charge an entertainment fee for each person who enters or who is present during the time live entertainment is in progress in the lounge area.

(y) (1) In Worcester County, the annual fees for the following types of licenses are:

(i) Six day – \$1,250; and

(ii) Seven day – \$1,500.

(2) Hotels and restaurants are defined to be:

(i) Six day license holders –

meals regularly; or

meals regularly; or

at least 70 people.

(ii) Seven day license holders –

incorporated by reference; and

which provide services found ordinarily in hotels, have a lobby with a registration and mail desk and seating facilities, and an enclosed dining area which serves full-course meals from menus at least twice daily or

from the sale of food in excess of that from the sale of alcoholic beverages during the effective period of the license.

(iii) A license may not be issued unless the hotel or restaurant is operated in a clean and sanitary manner and is equipped with the proper restroom facilities.

(3) Seven day license holders may sell beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) and beer and light wine (off-sale).

(4) If the premises to be licensed by the provisions of this subsection are within a municipal corporation, the license application may be subject to approval by its mayor and town council and shall be approved by the licensing authority.
