(a-2) (3) A license holder may obtain additional Class B (on-sale - hotels and restaurants) beer, wine and liquor licenses for premises operated as a public hotel which meet the minimum requirements identical to those described in [§ 19(aa)] § 19(A)(2) of this article, except, if the capital investment in the hotel exceeds \$3,000,000, the building height and elevator requirements provided in [§ 19(aa)] § 19(A)(2) do not apply and the minimum restaurant area seating capacity provided for in [§ 19(aa)] § 19(A)(2) shall be 100 persons.

(b) This section [shall] DOES not invalidate any license in any class which exceeds the maximum number of [said] THAT class at the time of effective date of this provision, but when any [such] licenses in excess of the number provided [hereby shall] IN THIS SECTION expire by virtue of revocation, cessation of [business] BUSINESS, or [not be renewed] NONRENEWAL, then [no] A new license [shall] MAY NOT be issued to replace it.

(c) This section [shall] DOES not apply to licenses issued under the provisions of [§§ 19(s)(2)] § 19(R)(2), [19(s)(5)] § 19(R)(5), or § 25 of this article.

(d) (1) In Prince George's County [no] A license [shall] MAY NOT be granted to sell alcoholic beverages in any building located within [one thousand] 1,000 feet of a school building, or within 500 feet of a church. The [one thousand] 1,000 feet, or the 500 feet, as the case may be, is to be measured from the front door or main entrance, whichever is nearest the street abutting the premises, of the proposed licensed establishment along the nearest usual pedestrian route to the door closest to the licensed premises which is used as an entrance or exit to any school, or to the main entrance of the church building[, provided that this].

(2) THIS restriction [shall] DOES not apply in the case of a church[, ] if the governing body of the church concerned [shall consent] CONSENTS in writing to the granting of [such] THE license[, which]. THE consent shall be filed with the application[, but the]. THE license of any person or persons or for the use of a corporation or unincorporated association issued for any building located within [such] THE REQUISITE distance from a church or school building may be renewed or extended for the same building.

(3) This [section shall] RESTRICTION DOES not apply to any transfer or assignment of a license located within the [aforesaid] distance of [one thousand] 1,000 feet to another place of business within the [aforesaid] SPECIFIED distance and/or to an assignee of [said] THE license within [said] THE distance of the same church or school building.

(4) This [section shall] DOES not apply to the issuance of a license for a place of business, not having an alcoholic beverage license, to which an alcoholic beverage license had been issued and was in force and effect on June 1, 1965, as to a license of the
