(IV) WARD 20, PRECINCTS 4 THROUGH 18, INCLUSIVE, AND 21;

(V) WARD 28, PRECINCTS 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, AND 17; AND

(VI) WARD 28, THAT PART OF PRECINCT 12 THAT IS EAST OF A LINE BEGINNING AT THE WESTERNMOST END OF THE ODD SIDE OF THE 4900 BLOCK OF WEST FOREST PARK AVENUE AND PROCEEDING IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION TO THE INTERSECTION WITH GWYNN'S FALLS.

(c) (1) Except as provided in subsection (h) of this section, the prohibitions in this section do not apply to special 1-day licenses or to Class B beer, wine and liquor restaurant licenses to bona fide restaurants having:

(i) A minimum capital investment, not including the cost of land and building, of:

A. \$250,000 for restaurant facilities in the 47th [legislative] ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES district of Baltimore City [; or] WHICH CONSISTS OF:

1. WARDS 23, 24, AND 25 IN THEIR ENTIRETY;

2. WARD 19, PRECINCTS 3, 4, AND 5;

3. WARD 20, PRECINCTS 19 AND 20;

4. WARD 21, PRECINCTS 2 AND 3; AND

5. WARD 21, THAT PART OF PRECINCT 1 THAT LIES SOUTH AND WEST OF A LINE THAT RUNS ALONG THE CENTER OF HARBOR CITY BOULEVARD FROM EUTAW STREET TO PRATT STREET; OR

B. \$200,000 for restaurant facilities in the remainder of Baltimore City; and
