The liquor control board of each county shall have full power and authority within its county:

- (a) (1) (I) To appoint such employees as may be necessary to conduct such county liquor dispensary or branch dispensaries, fix their compensation and require such bonds [from] FOR the faithful performance of their duties as the board may in each case determine.
- (II) In Montgomery County, effective July 1, 1951, the positions of General Manager and Treasurer of the Liquor Control Board are hereby abolished. All existing employees of the Board, except those whose positions are abolished herein, shall be entitled to continue to be employed on probation of six months duration at their existing salaries subject to passing qualifying examinations and regulations of the County Personnel Board. All employees of the Department except the Director shall be appointed and hold their positions subject to [said] THE regulations. The office of the County Attorney shall furnish legal services to the Department.
