(H) WHENEVER THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ANY COUNTY IN THIS STATE PUBLISHES OR ISSUES IN PRINTED, MIMEOGRAPHED, OR SIMILAR DUPLICATED FORM A CODE OR COMPILATION CONTAINING ALL OR A PORTION OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF THE COUNTY, THE COUNCIL SHALL DEPOSIT COPIES FREE OF CHARGE WITH THE FOLLOWING STATE AGENCIES: STATE ARCHIVES, 1 COPY; STATE LAW LIBRARY, 1 COPY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE, 5 COPIES.
