(H) WHENEVER A CODE COUNTY IN THIS STATE PUBLISHES OR ISSUES IN PRINTED, MIMEOGRAPHED, OR SIMILAR DUPLICATED FORM A CODE OR COMPILATION CONTAINING ALL OR A PORTION OF THE PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF THE COUNTY, THE CODE COUNTY SHALL DEPOSIT COPIES FREE OF CHARGE WITH THE FOLLOWING STATE AGENCIES: STATE ARCHIVES, 1 COPY; STATE LAW LIBRARY, 1 COPY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE, 5 COPIES.

DRAFTER'S NOTE:

This clarifies current practice applicable to code counties with regard to the submission to various State agencies of changes in their codes of public local laws.

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

(c) As used in this section, a “nunchaku” is a device constructed of two pieces of any substance, including wood, metal, or plastic, connected by any chain, rope, leather or other flexible material[, and] not exceeding 24 inches in length.

(c) (1) Nothing in this section shall prevent the wearing, carrying, or transporting of a handgun [by] BY: (i) law-enforcement personnel of the United States, or of this State, or of any county or city of this State[,]; (ii) members of the armed forces of the United States or of the National Guard while on duty or traveling to or from duty; [or] (iii) law-enforcement personnel of some other state or subdivision thereof temporarily in this State on official business; (iv) any jailer, prison guard, warden, or guard or keeper at any penal, correctional or detention institution in this State; or (v) sheriffs and temporary or full-time sheriffs' deputies, as to all of whom this exception shall apply only when they are on active assignment engaged in law enforcement; provided, that any such person mentioned in this paragraph is duly authorized at the time and under the circumstances he is wearing, carrying, or transporting the weapon to wear, carry, or transport such weapon as part of his official equipment.
