(e) (5) [It shall be unlawful for any] AN individual, including [but not limited to employees] AN EMPLOYEE of the State Fire Marshal, [from giving] MAY NOT GIVE prior notice of any inspection [as] authorized by this subtitle, without the written approval of the State Fire Marshal or [his] A designee OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

(d) It is unlawful to manufacture or process fireworks in the State of Maryland except in a licensed fireworks plant. Any person, firm, or corporation manufacturing or processing fireworks in this State at any location other than A licensed fireworks plant is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00 or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.

Before a license or permit may be issued under this article to an employer to engage in an activity in which the [employee] EMPLOYER may employ a covered [employer] EMPLOYEE, as defined in § 9-101 of the Labor and Employment Article, the employer shall file with the issuing authority:

- (1) A certificate of compliance with the Maryland Workers’ Compensation Act; or
- (2) The number of a workers’ compensation insurance policy or binder.
