(e) Professional solicitors shall file with the Secretary of State a copy of any agreement entered into with a charitable organization within 10 days of its execution. A person may not lawfully act as a professional solicitor for a charitable organization unless the entire agreement between the parties is reduced to writing. Such agreements shall:

(2) Have as an attachment a written text containing the wording which shall be used by the professional solicitor or solicitors when conducting all oral or written solicitations and which shall include, but not be limited to:

(iv) A statement that a copy of the charitable organization's financial statement is available, and will be provided by the person making the solicitation upon request; AND

(3) [Other] INCLUDE OTHER information as prescribed by the Secretary of State by regulation.

(d) Subject to the authority of the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services, the Commission is vested with the following authority, responsibility and duty:

(14) To consult and cooperate with other departments and agencies of the State concerned with police training; AND

(h) (1) A police officer's certificate, provided for in [paragraph (6) of subsection (d)] SUBSECTION (D)(6) OF THIS SECTION, shall automatically lapse 3 years from the date of the previous certification.

(2) The Commission may recertify a police officer, provided for in [paragraph (6) of subsection (d)] SUBSECTION (D)(6) OF THIS SECTION, upon:

(i) An automatic lapse of the certificate; or

(ii) A revocation of a certification.
