- (j) (1) A person may not be employed as a police officer by any law enforcement unit for a period to exceed 12 months unless that person is certified by the Commission, as provided for in [paragraph (6), subsection (d)] SUBSECTION (D)(6) OF THIS SECTION of this section.
- (k) A certificate, provided for in [paragraph (6), subsection (d)] SUBSECTION (D)(6) OF THIS SECTION, shall remain the property of the Police Training Commission.
- (1) The Commission may recall the certificate, provided for in [paragraph (6), subsection (d)] SUBSECTION (D)(6) OF THIS SECTION, if it is suspended or revoked for any of the following reasons:
 - (1) The certificate was issued by administrative error;
 - (2) The certificate was obtained through misrepresentation or fraud;
 - (3) The holder has been convicted of a felony; or
- (4) The holder has been convicted of a misdemeanor for which a sentence of imprisonment for more than 1 year may be imposed.
