

(C) (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION.

(2) EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE A CITIZEN AND A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.

(D) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(E) STAFF FOR THE COMMISSION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND VETERANS COMMISSION.

(F) THE COMMISSION SHALL, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE:

(1) REPORT ITS INITIAL RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY JANUARY 1, 1992; AND

(2) SUBMIT ITS FINAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY SEPTEMBER 1, 1992.

Article 48A - Insurance Code

48.

(5) To qualify for authority to engage in the business of any one kind of insurance business, unless otherwise provided in this article, an insurer commencing business in this State on or after July 1, 1991, shall possess and thereafter maintain paid-in capital stock having a fixed nominal or par value in an amount not less than as applicable under the following schedule:

Kind or Kinds of Insurance Business	Minimum Capital Stock Required
(a) Life, including annuities .....	\$1,500,000
(b) Health .....	750,000
(c) Property and marine other than wet marine and transportation...	750,000
(d) Title .....	750,000
