(g) (1) An employee who, in the actual performance of his job duties, sustains an accidental PERSONAL injury which would be compensable under the Maryland Workers' Compensation Act shall be granted accident leave with full sick pay if, after medical examination, a physician certifies that the injury or accident disables the employee.

**Article 66B – Zoning and Planning**

3.09.

The planning commission shall annually prepare, adopt, and file an annual report with the local legislative body. The annual report shall be made available for public inspection and a copy of the report shall be mailed to the Director of THE MARYLAND OFFICE OF Planning. The annual report shall (a) index and locate on a map all changes in development patterns including land use, transportation, community facilities patterns, zoning map amendments, and subdivision plats which occurred during the period covered by the report, and shall state whether these changes are or are not consistent with each other, with the recommendations of the last annual report, with adopted plans of the jurisdiction, with adopted plans of all adjoining planning jurisdictions, and with adopted plans of State and local jurisdictions that have responsibility for financing or constructing public improvements necessary to implement the jurisdiction's plan; (b) contain statements and recommendations for improving the planning and development process within the jurisdiction. The local legislative body shall review the annual report and direct that such studies and other actions as appropriate and necessary be undertaken to insure the continuation of a viable planning and development process.

(a) Any local government agency may apply to the Director for a State grant for the cost of:
