

CHAPTER 3

(Senate Bill 35)

AN ACT concerning

Homeowners Tax Credit Local Supplement – Applicability

FOR the purpose of altering the taxable year in which a certain homeowners tax credit local supplement may apply if the supplement is adopted by the governing body of a municipal corporation; and making this Act an emergency measure.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Chapter 129 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991
Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 129 of the Acts of 1991

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991 and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, [1992] 1991.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 4

(Senate Bill 1)

AN ACT concerning

Business Regulation

FOR the purpose of adding a new article to the Annotated Code of Maryland, to be designated and known as the "Business Regulation Article", to revise, restate, and recodify the laws of the State relating and pertaining to: the Uniform Preservation of Private Business Records Act, trademarks, service marks, and certain trade names, the Department of Licensing and Regulation, amusement attractions and amusement rides, boxing, kick boxing, and wrestling, sports agents, cemetery
