(a) (4) (i) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, an applicant shall have received training by:

1. serving as a registered apprentice as provided under §§ 5-404[(b)] and 5-405(d) of this title; or

2. successfully completing the required program in a cosmetology school that is approved by the State Board of Education or the Maryland Higher Education Commission in consultation with the Board.

(ii) If an applicant is a journey barber or master barber currently licensed in this State, the Board shall:

1. credit the applicant with having met [one half] ONE-HALF of the training requirements of subparagraph (i) of this paragraph; and

2. determine the manner in which the credit will be applied.
