[(1)](A) Subject to [paragraphs (2)] SUBSECTIONS (B) through [(4)] (D) of this section and while a license to practice cosmetology is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to practice cosmetology.

[(2)](B) While a limited license to provide makeup artist services is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide only makeup artist services.

[(3)](C) While a limited license to provide esthetic services is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide only esthetic services.

[(4)](D) While a limited license to provide manicuring services is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide only manicuring services.
