- (a) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Department in connection with an order or license issued under this [subtitle] TITLE may take a direct judicial appeal. 8-509.
- (a) (1) A person who fails, refuses, or neglects to comply with any provision of this title, or with any [rule or] regulation adopted under this title, is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.
- (b) (1) In addition to any criminal penalty imposed under this section, a person who violates any provision of this title, any [rule, regulation,] REGULATION or order issued under this title, or any term, condition, or limitation of any license or registration certificate issued under this title:
- (i) Is liable for a civil penalty not exceeding \$10,000, to be collected in a civil action in the circuit court for any county; and
 - (ii) May be enjoined from continuing the violation.

(a) In addition to any other remedies available at law or in equity and after an opportunity for a hearing which may be waived in writing by the person accused of a violation, the Department may impose a penalty for violation of any provision of this title, or any [rule,] regulation, order, plan for compliance, registration, certificate, or license adopted or issued under this title.
