Error: Obsolete terminology in § 9-210(b)(3) of the Environment Article.

Occurred: As a result of Ch. 640, Acts of 1991, which replaced the defined term "used tires" with "scrap tires". Section 9-228(f) of the Environment Article, as enacted by Ch. 640, Acts of 1991, regulates disposal of scrap tires in landfills.

(b) A person may not store scrap tires in the State unless the person demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Department that, within 90 days of the time that the person stores the scrap tires, the scrap tires will be:

(4) Transferred, by means of a scrap tire hauler, to any facility within the scrap tire recycling system established under subsection [(b)] (C) of this section.

- (1) This subtitle;
- (2) Any regulation adopted under this subtitle; or
