- [(1)](i) 1. Have a baccalaureate or masters degree in health care administration from an accredited college or university; or
- [(ii) 1.] 2. A. Have a baccalaureate or masters degree in a field other than health care administration from an accredited college or university; and
- [2.] B. Have satisfactorily completed a minimum of 100 hours in a course of study in health care administration, or its equivalent, approved by the Board; and
- [(iii)]II) 1. Have completed an administrator-in-training program approved by the Board; or
- 2. Have completed 1 year of full-time nursing home administration in a nursing home.
- (2) The requirements of paragraph (1) of this subsection do not apply to an individual who:
 - (i) Was in possession of a valid license on December 15, 1988; or
 - (ii) 1. Had applied for a license by December 15, 1988; and
 - 2. Met all of the other requirements for licensure.
