

4-204. QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION; STAFF; OFFICE.

(A) QUORUM; VOTING.

(1) A MAJORITY OF THE AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.

(2) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT ACT UNLESS A MAJORITY OF THE AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP CONCURS.

(B) MEETINGS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL SET THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

(1) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION IS ENTITLED TO:

(I) AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$3,500; AND

(II) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(2) EACH OTHER MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS ENTITLED TO:

(I) AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$2,500; AND

(II) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) SURETY BOND.

WHILE IN OFFICE, EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE COVERED BY A SURETY BOND IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT REQUIRED BY LAW.

(E) STAFF.

THE COMMISSION MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

(F) OFFICE.

THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE ITS GENERAL OFFICES IN BALTIMORE CITY.
