(a) (4) The Commission shall approve or disapprove the application within the later to occur of 30 days after receipt of all required information or 5 days after approval by the Secretary of State of the public offering statement. Should the application be disapproved, a hearing shall be afforded the applicant in conformance with [§ 225 of Article 56] § 16-324 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE. Approved registrations shall expire on the 30th day of April in each even numbered year or on such other day as the Commission may designate.
