**Article – State Finance and Procurement**

7-108.

(a) In accordance with the Maryland Constitution and other law, the Governor shall include in each budget bill:

(4) without revision, the appropriations requested for the Judicial Branch of the State government, as certified by the [Comptroller] CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;
