

(B) POWERS.

THE COMMISSION MAY:

- (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ADMINISTER ITS OFFICE;
- (2) ADMINISTER OATHS; AND
- (3) ISSUE SUBPOENAS FOR THE ATTENDANCE OF WITNESSES TO TESTIFY OR TO PRODUCE EVIDENCE.

(C) DUTIES.

THE COMMISSION SHALL:

- (1) ADOPT A SEAL;
- (2) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE AND SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS TITLE;
- (3) KEEP A RECORD OF ITS PROCEEDINGS;
- (4) KEEP AT ITS GENERAL OFFICES ALL ITS BOOKS, DOCUMENTS, AND PAPERS; AND
- (5) PREPARE NOTICES AND OTHER PAPERS FOR SERVICE.

(D) ANNUAL REPORT.

THE COMMISSION:

(1) SHALL SUBMIT ANNUALLY TO THE SECRETARY FOR THE YEAR THAT ENDS ON JUNE 30:

- (I) A REPORT OF ITS PROCEEDINGS; AND
- (II) A DETAILED STATEMENT OF ALL RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS; AND

(2) MAY SUBMIT WITH ITS ANNUAL REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS ABOUT ITS AFFAIRS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, §§ 112(a)(1) and (b), 126(b)(2), the third clause of the fifth sentence of § 109, and the second, fifth, and sixth sentences of § 110.

In subsection (a) of this section, the reference to the Commission having control and jurisdiction over "all contests held in the State" is substituted for the former reference to "all professional kick boxing, boxing and sparring and wrestling matches and exhibitions to be conducted, held or given within the State" to use the defined term "contest" and for brevity.
