- (d) (2) A nonresident may apply for and be accepted for enrollment in courses authorized under this subtitle; however, the reimbursement provided under [§ 16-605(f)] § 16-605(E) may not be made for a nonresident trainee.
- (3) An eligible individual may take a course more than one time, but the reimbursement provided in [ $\S$  16-605(f)]  $\S$  16-605(E) of this subtitle may only be paid one time for any individual.

- (a) In this [section] SECTION, "highway work zone" means a construction or maintenance area on or alongside a highway that is marked by appropriate warning signs or other traffic control devices designating that work is in progress.
- (b) The STATE HIGHWAY Administration may reduce established speed limits in a highway work zone upon a determination that the change is necessary to ensure the public safety.
