

(ii) Any civilian employee of the Maryland State Police assigned to enforce any rule or regulation adopted under this section, but only while acting under written authorization of the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police; or

(iii) Any civilian employee of a local government who is:

1. Acting under the immediate direction and control of a uniformed police officer;

2. Acting under the written authorization of the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police; and

[(iii)] 3. Certified by the Maryland State Police to perform an inspection authorized under this section.
