(4) Maryland State Police:

(a) Convert facility in Prince Frederick for use as State Police Barracks (Calvert County). THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS IN THIS APPROPRIATION NOT ENCUMBERED FOR THE PURPOSES IDENTIFIED ABOVE AS OF JUNE 1, 1992 SHALL BE USED TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A NEW GARRETT COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER (GARRETT COUNTY)..... 750,000

Section 1(3)

(J) Morgan State University (Baltimore City):

(1) Design and prepare preliminary plans and specifications AND PROVIDE A PORTION OF THE FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT [for] THE Engineering Building..... 335,000

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING, ANY APPROPRIATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OR EQUIPMENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT THAT IS IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT NEEDED FOR A PROJECT MAY BE CREDITED TO THE CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY FUND CREATED BY THE MARYLAND CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN OF 1992. PROVIDED THAT AN APPROPRIATION MAY NOT BE CREDITED TO THE CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY FUND UNTIL A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT HAS BEEN AWARDED.

(e) Not more than \$1,500,000 to provide loans or loan guarantees for projects for industrial pretreatment. THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS IN THIS APPROPRIATION NOT ENCUMBERED FOR THE PURPOSES IDENTIFIED ABOVE AS OF JUNE 1, 1992 SHALL BE USED TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR PROJECTS TO REMOVE NUTRIENTS AT PUBLICLY OWNED SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS.
