## Chapter 365 of the Acts of 1990

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:
- (I) as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the purpose of RENOVATING, repairing, improving, CONSTRUCTING, expanding, and equipping the Baltimore City Jail; OR
- (II) FOR USE BY THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES:
- 1. FOR RENOVATING, REPAIRING, IMPROVING, CONSTRUCTING, EXPANDING, AND EQUIPPING THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER: OR
- TO PROVIDE, ON THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF FUNDS PUBLIC WORKS. A PORTION OF THE FOR THE STATE CONTINGENCY FACILITIES FUND **PURSUANT** CORRECTIONAL TO CHAPTER 472 OF THE ACTS OF 1991.

## Chapter 472 of the Acts of 1991

- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT ANY BOND PROCEEDS REMAINING ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1992 FROM ANY APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES CONTINGENCY FUND UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT, MAY BE EXPENDED, UPON APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, FOR ANY PURPOSE SPECIFIED IN THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL LOANS OF 1986 THROUGH 1990, AS AMENDED, PROVIDED THAT:
- (1) THE TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF BOND PROCEEDS UNDER THIS PROVISION FROM THE STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES CONTINGENCY FUND FOR THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL OR THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER MAY NOT EXCEED THE TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS UNDER THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL LOANS OF 1986 THROUGH 1990, AS AMENDED, REMAINING AS OF JANUARY 1, 1992;
- (2) FOLLOWING THE EXPENDITURE OF UNSPENT BOND PROCEEDS FROM THE STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES CONTINGENCY FUND PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, AN EQUIVALENT AMOUNT OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ANY OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL LOANS OF 1986
