

It is also the intent of the General Assembly that, to the maximum extent possible, funding for vision-to-scale agreements should be made utilizing any available fiscal 1998 appropriations, thereby potentially increasing both the number and scale of vision-to-scale agreements that may be funded during fiscal 1999.
