It is also the intent of the General Assembly that, to the maximum extent possible, funding for vision—to—scale agreements should be made utilizing any available fiscal 1998 appropriations, thereby potentially increasing both the number and scale of vision—to—scale agreements that may be funded during fiscal 1999.
