- (1) the institution determines through a an internal competitive evaluation process which programs, departments, or activities are to be enhanced:
- (2) a report is submitted to the budget committees which, for each proposed enhancement, provides:
 - (a) detailed justification, including expected outcomes; and
 - (b) budgetary detail indicating the number of positions, expenditures by object, and total funding required in fiscal 1999 and thereafter; and
- (3) the budget eemmittee committees

 have reviewed and commented on the
 report or 45 days have elapsed from
 receipt of the report.

 Further provided that it is the intent
 of the General Assembly that these
 funds shall be directed to instruction
 and research infrastructure.
