

- (1) THE PROGRESS OF THE RESIDENTIAL CONSERVATION SERVICE PLAN;
- (2) COMMISSION ACTIVITIES TO MODERATE PEAK ELECTRIC DEMAND; AND
- (3) ENERGY CONSERVATION MEASURES TAKEN BY GAS COMPANIES AND ELECTRIC COMPANIES IN THE STATE TO REDUCE ELECTRICAL AND NATURAL GAS DEMAND.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78, § 57. It is revised to conform to the long-standing practice of the Commission. See Ch. 462, Acts of 1982.

In subsection (a)(1) of this section, the former reference to "mak[ing]" an annual report is deleted as unnecessary in light of the requirement to "publish" the report.

In subsection (a)(1)(i) of this section, the former reference to "rules" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to "regulation[s]". See General Revisor's Note to this article.

Also in subsection (a)(1)(i) of this section, the reference to a "summary" of each regulation, opinion, or order of the Commission is added for clarity.

SUBTITLE 2. PEOPLE'S COUNSEL.

2-201. "RESIDENTIAL AND NONCOMMERCIAL USERS" DEFINED.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "RESIDENTIAL AND NONCOMMERCIAL USERS" MEANS:

- (1) RESIDENTIAL USERS OF GAS, ELECTRICITY, TELEPHONES, OR WATER AND SEWERAGE; AND
- (2) NONCOMMERCIAL USERS OF OTHER SERVICES REGULATED BY THE COMMISSION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first sentence of former Art. 78, § 15(a) as it defined "residential and noncommercial users".

In item (2) of this section, the reference to services regulated by "the Commission" is added for clarity.
