The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may waive the requirements of this subtitle for a private review agent that operates solely under contract with the federal government for utilization review of patients eligible for hospital services under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act.

15-10B-13.

The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER shall periodically provide a list of private review agents issued certificates and the renewal date for those certificates te:

- (1) The Maryland Chamber of Commerce;
- (2) The Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland;
- (3) The Maryland Hospital Association;
- (4) All hospital-utilization review programs; and
- $\stackrel{\hbox{\scriptsize (5)}}{}$ Any other business or labor organization requesting the list $\stackrel{\hbox{\scriptsize TO ANY}}{}$ PERSON ON REQUEST.

15-10B-14.

The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may establish reporting requirements to:

- (1) Evaluate the effectiveness of private review agents; and
- (2) Determine if the utilization review programs are in compliance with the provisions of this section and applicable regulations.

15-10B-17.

- (b) (1) In addition to the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, the [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may impose an administrative penalty of up to \$1,000 \$5,000 for a violation of any provision of this subtitle.
- (2) The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER shall adopt regulations to provide standards for the imposition of an administrative penalty under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(a) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the [Secretary] COMMISSIONER in a contested case under this subtitle may take a direct judicial appeal.
