- (b) The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may revoke a certificate if the holder does not comply with performance assurances under this section, violates any provision of this subtitle, or violates any regulation adopted under any provision of this subtitle.
- (c) (1) Before denying or revoking a certificate under this section, the [Secretary] COMMISSIONER shall provide the applicant or certificate holder with reasonable time to supply additional information demonstrating compliance with the requirements of this subtitle and the opportunity to request a hearing.
- (2) If an applicant or certificate holder requests a hearing, the [Secretary] COMMISSIONER shall send a hearing notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, at least 30 days before the hearing.
- (3) The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER shall hold the hearing in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 2 of the State Government Article.

15-10B-12.

The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may waive the requirements of this subtitle for a private review agent that operates solely under contract with the federal government for utilization review of patients eligible for hospital services under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act.

15-10B-13.

The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER shall periodically provide a list of private review agents issued certificates and the renewal date for those certificates to:

- (1) The Maryland Chamber of Commerce:
- (2) The Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland;
- (3) The Maryland-Hospital Association;
- (4) All hospital utilization review programs; and
- $\phantom{+}$  (5) Any other business or labor organization requesting the list  $\underline{\text{ANY}}$  PERSON ON REQUEST.

15-10B-14.

The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may establish reporting requirements to:

- (1) Evaluate the effectiveness of private review agents; and
- (2) Determine if the utilization review programs are in compliance with the provisions of this section and applicable regulations.

15-10B-17.

(b) (1) In addition to the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, the [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may impose an administrative penalty of up to \$1,000 \$5,000 for a violation of any provision of this subtitle.
