

(2) DOES NOT HAVE ACCESS TO HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE THAT COVERS SCREENING MAMMOGRAMS AND CLINICAL BREAST EXAMINATIONS FOR WOMEN AGED 40 YEARS AND OLDER.

(E) FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN APPROPRIATION OF GENERAL FUNDS TO THE PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR BREAST CANCER SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS, AND TREATMENT IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999, SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF STATE FUNDS.

(E) BEGINNING FISCAL YEAR 1999, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE AT LEAST \$4,200,000 EACH YEAR FROM ITS GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION TO FUND THE PROGRAM TO EXPAND UPON THE EXISTING FEDERALLY FUNDED CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING PROGRAM.

(E) (1) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 1999, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON ITS PROGRESS ON, AND ITS PLANS FOR, IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS PROGRAM, INCLUDING FUNDING FOR SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS, AND TREATMENT.

(2) TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOCATE FROM ITS GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION, AS WELL AS OTHER APPROPRIATE FUNDING SOURCES, AT LEAST:

(I) \$2,600,000 FOR FISCAL YEARS 1999, 2000, AND 2001, AND

(II) \$4,200,000 FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2002

(F) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN:

(1) \$2,600,000 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR THAT BEGINS ON JULY 1, 1999;

(2) \$2,600,000 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR THAT BEGINS ON JULY 1, 2000; AND

(3) \$4,200,000 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR THAT BEGINS ON JULY 1, 2001 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR.

(F) (G) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM; AND

(2) WORK WITH THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES TO CONTINUE TO ASSURE THAT BREAST CANCER SCREENING SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE TO WOMEN AT LEAST 40 YEARS OLD:

(I) THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT;

(II) LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS IN THE STATE;

(III) THE HEALTH SERVICES COST REVIEW COMMISSION;
