- (2) (D) IF THE TRANSFEROR IS A NONPROFIT HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION, THE TRANSFEROR SHALL NOTIFY EACH ENROLLEE OF THE NONPROFIT—HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION OF THE PROPOSED TRANSACTION BY FIRST CLASS MAIL WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

- (A) WITHIN 10 WORKING DAYS AFTER RECEIVING AN APPLICATION, THE APPROPRIATE REGULATING ENTITY SHALL:
- (1) PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE NONPROFIT HEALTH ENTITY IS LOCATED THE MOST WIDELY CIRCULATED NEWSPAPERS THAT ARE PART OF A NONPROFIT HEALTH ENTITY'S SERVICE AREA; AND
- (2) NOTIFY BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL ANY PERSON WHO THAT HAS REQUESTED IN WRITING NOTICE OF THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION.
 - (B) THE NOTICE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL:
 - (1) STATE THAT AN APPLICATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED,
 - (2) STATE THE NAMES OF THE PARTIES TO THE ACQUISITION;
 - (3) DESCRIBE THE CONTENTS OF THE APPLICATION:
- (4) STATE THE DATE BY WHICH A PERSON MUST SUBMIT WRITTEN COMMENTS ON THE APPLICATION; AND
- (5) PROVIDE THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ACQUISITION.
- (C) THE APPLICANT SHALL BEAR THE COST OF THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(A) WITHIN 65 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING AN APPLICATION

- (1) AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE, BUT NO LATER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A COMPLETED COMPLETE APPLICATION, INCLUDING ALL NECESSARY EXPERT REPORTS, THE APPROPRIATE REGULATING ENTITY SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING.
- (2) IF THE NONPROFIT HEALTH ENTITY IS A HOSPITAL, THE REGULATING ENTITY SHALL HOLD THE PUBLIC HEARING IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH THE HOSPITAL IS LOCATED.
