AN ACT concerning

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to apply to the federal Health Care Financing Administration for a certain home and community based services waiver to provide certain services to certain individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders; requiring the Department to conduct a certain study and report the results of the study to the General Assembly; and generally relating to the provision of certain services to certain individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders.

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to investigate the development of integrated care systems and the feasibility and desirability of applying to the federal Health Care Financing Administration for a waiver to provide certain home—and community—based services to certain adults with functional disabilities, including individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders; requiring the Department to conduct a certain study and report the results of the study to the General Assembly; and generally relating to studying the provision of certain services to certain adults with functional disabilities, including individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders.
