**MISCELLANEOUS GRANT PROGRAMS**

(A) Silver Spring Revitalization. Provide a grant to Montgomery County to acquire property, design, construct, equip, and renovate facilities for the Silver Spring Revitalization Project, subject to the requirement that Montgomery County provide an equal and matching fund. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may include expenditures made after June 1, 1993, for property acquisition and the relocation of occupants of structures demolished or to be demolished within the Silver Spring Urban Renewal Project Area, and for the design, construction, renovation, and equipping of facilities for this project.
