## Maryland Medical Assistance Program – <del>Durable Medical Equipment</del> Suppliers Historic Providers – Definition

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to consider a supplier of durable medical equipment to be a historic provider for certain purposes under certain circumstances; prohibiting a managed care organization from contracting for the provision of durable medical equipment to Program recipients with a supplier that lacks certain accreditation; and generally relating to the suppliers of durable medical equipment within altering the definition of "historic provider" to include certain licensed residential service agencies that, as of a certain date, had a demonstrated history of providing services to program recipients under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program; and generally relating to the definition of "historic provider" for purposes of the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.
