- (d) Except as provided in subsection (e) of this section and to the extent feasible and appropriate, the Department shall reuse the durable medical equipment recovered under subsection (e) of this section to meet the needs of other Program recipients for the same-durable medical equipment.
- (e) If the durable medical equipment recovered under subsection (e) of this section is not in a condition that would enable another Program recipient to use it, the Department may give the equipment to any organization that will:
  - (1) Repair or attempt to repair the equipment; and
- (2) Provide the equipment at no charge to other persons who require the same equipment.
- (F) A MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION MAY NOT CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT TO PROCRAM RECIPIENTS WITH A SUPPLIER THAT IS NOT ACCREDITED BY THE JOINT COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION OF HEALTHCARE ORGANIZATIONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
